

Competition Conduct

When we go to competitions, we represent, not only ourselves, but Century Winterguard, Band, and the school as a whole. Think about how you want people to see you, and what sort of message your actions send.

Some general guidelines to follow:

- No foul language, or unkind words including those aimed towards yourself.
- Never talk about another group, *especially* in the stands, even positive words can be taken out of context.
- While shows can be very fun, remember that you are there to do an important job. Shows are never the time to make unhealthy choices, or to decide what you think should be a priority.
- The staff will always do their best to inform you of the schedule and any plans for the day, but the nature of a competition does not always allow us to give you much information ahead of time. You should always be ready to drop what you are doing and change focus in a moment's notice.
